**6.** The Martian alphabet has *M* letters. Marvin writes down a word and notices that within every sub-word (a contiguous stretch of letters) at least one letter occurs an odd number of times. What is the length of the longest possible word he could have written?



**7.** For a long space journey, two astronauts with compatible personalities are to be selected from 24 candidates. To find a good fit, each candidate was asked 24 questions that required a simple *yes* or *no* answer.

Two astronauts are compatible if exactly 12 of their answers matched (that is, both answered *yes* or both answered *no*). Miraculously, every pair of these 24 astronauts was compatible!

Show that there were exactly 12 astronauts whose answer to the question "Can you repair a flux capacitor?" was exactly the same as their answer to the question "Are you afraid of heights?" (that is, *yes* to both or *no* to both).
