The game of Sprouts

Instructions: The game of Sprouts is a pencil-and-paper game that you will play with your partner. Here are the rules:

- 1. Start by drawing two dots on your paper.
- 2. Players take turn making moves. To make a move, you must
 - a. either draw a line between two dots on your paper or draw a loop from one dot back to itself, and then
 - b. draw a new dot on the new line.
- 3. But there's a catch!
 - a. The line you draw does not need to be straight, but it cannot cross itself or any pre-existing lines on the paper.
 - b. No dot can have more than three lines attached to it.
 - c. A line that connects a dot back to itself in a loop counts as TWO lines that touch the dot.
- 4. The player who makes the last move wins.

Play Sprouts with your partner. Keep track of who wins. Try to come up with a strategy for one of the players. What happens if you start with more than two dots? What if you start with one dot?
